- o. Kory Morgan-working with recovery options to bring to community; working with Wisconsin Voices for Recovery supports and services; will be bringing them in to talk to group
- p. Judge Hepler-Adult Drug Treatment Court started in September; have started 6 participants; there are challenges with transportation, treatment access and mental health services
- q. Clint Starks- Heather Kierzek will be covering both OWI and Drug Court for the time being; tele-health contract almost here
- r. Jake Neisum-Working on sober living in Portage, controlled substances not allowed-too hard to monitor. Shared his story and some information on the ROOTS program in Milwaukee
- s. Amanda Riek-working on reform group when referring; working on lunch and learns with Bar Assoc, regarding MATRS and related programming for clients; March 15<sup>th</sup> debate in Columbus-live stream,
